CODE OF CONDUCT

- Kx2 Music has a strict zero-tolerance policy against bullying in any form. A positive and focused learning environment is key to musical success and overall well-being.
 - Respect towards teachers and peers is mandatory.
 - Teachers will work with each student to determine their readiness to thrive within our studio.
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LESSONS & CLASSES

- Students are required to bring a folder or binder and their individual instrument (if applicable) every week.
 - No cell phones, food, or drink (other than water) in the studio rooms.
 - Last-minute changes regarding lesson time, instrument, repertoire, etc. are not guaranteed.
 - A Google Sheet/Google Drive Folder will be shared with a parent email, and updated by the teacher every week.
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MAINSTAGE

- Auditions & Casting: Role placements take place on the first day. Casting decisions are based on vocal, acting, & dance suitability for roles.
 - Attendance: Auditions and Tech Week attendance are strictly mandatory for all cast members. Regular attendance is required. Unexcused absences may result in role reassignment.
 - Production fees cover scripts, costumes, licensing, and theatre rental.
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PERFORMANCES

- Recitals: We hold a Fall and Spring Recital annually.
- Students may be invited to perform at other opportunities throughout the year.
- New students must complete 10 lessons before participating in performances.
- Solos must adhere to a 4-minute limit to respect event timing.
- Attendance at the final lesson, class, or rehearsal prior to a performance is mandatory for participation.

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SCHEDULING & CANCELLATION

- Lessons/Classes are recurring weekly. Please view the Google Calendar shared with your email.
 - The scheduling calendar resets each school year. You will receive a link on July 1 to re-register for a time slot.
 - Scheduling changes must be communicated by parents if students are under 18.
 - Lessons cancelled with 24+ hours notice will be rescheduled.
 - In the case of a late cancellation or emergency, a virtual lesson or reschedule may be offered at the teacher's discretion. If declined, the lesson is forfeited.
 - Any lesson time missed by a teacher will be made up.
 - To maintain a healthy environment, students exhibiting symptoms of illness should not attend in-person.
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TUITION

- Private Lessons: Save \$50 when paying the full semester balance by Day 1 (Card or Zelle). Two-payment installment and monthly auto-pay plans are also available.
 - Semester Commitment: Enrollment for the full semester is required following your introductory lesson.
 - Loyalty Lock: Private lesson tuition rates will never increase for continuously enrolled students!
 - Group Classes: Save \$100 when enrolling in all 3 sessions. Save \$25 on an additional class for yourself or a family member. VIP Perk: Private lesson students get free studio merch when adding a group class! Current students can skip the online registration form and re-enroll or add classes directly via Venmo or Zelle.
 - MainStages, Pop-Ups, & Camps: Class discounts do not apply to MainStage Productions, Pop-Ups, or Summer Camps (dedicated early bird pricing or special discounts are offered for these programs).
 - Rolling Admission: Prorated tuition is available for late enrollment (discounts do not apply)
 - All payments are final and non-refundable. Credits may be applied toward future sessions at studio discretion.
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AGREEMENT

- The Student/Parent is responsible for any damage caused to Kx2 Music equipment.
- The Teacher must be informed of any medical or learning conditions affecting the Student.
- Media Release: Photos and Videos taken during Recitals, Classes, Lessons, Shows, Summer Camps, or other various performances may be shared on official Kx2 Music platforms.
- Parents/Guardians are responsible for the supervision of students before and after their scheduled class time.
- If the Student is under the age of 18, the Parent/Guardian gives permission for the Teacher to teach the Student at the agreed location and scheduled time.
